

This is an excellent book for anyone who wants to start making music on their iPad or iPhone (although the chapter on MIDI cannot be done on an iPhone, everything else can). If you have a lot of music apps, but mostly play them standalone, this book will also teach you how to use Audioshare and Audiobus, as well as Inter App Audio, the three most important technologies for getting apps to work together. I have not seen a better introduction to multi-app music anywhere. This book is a must-have for beginners, and even experienced musicians are likely to learn something new. Strongly recommended!
