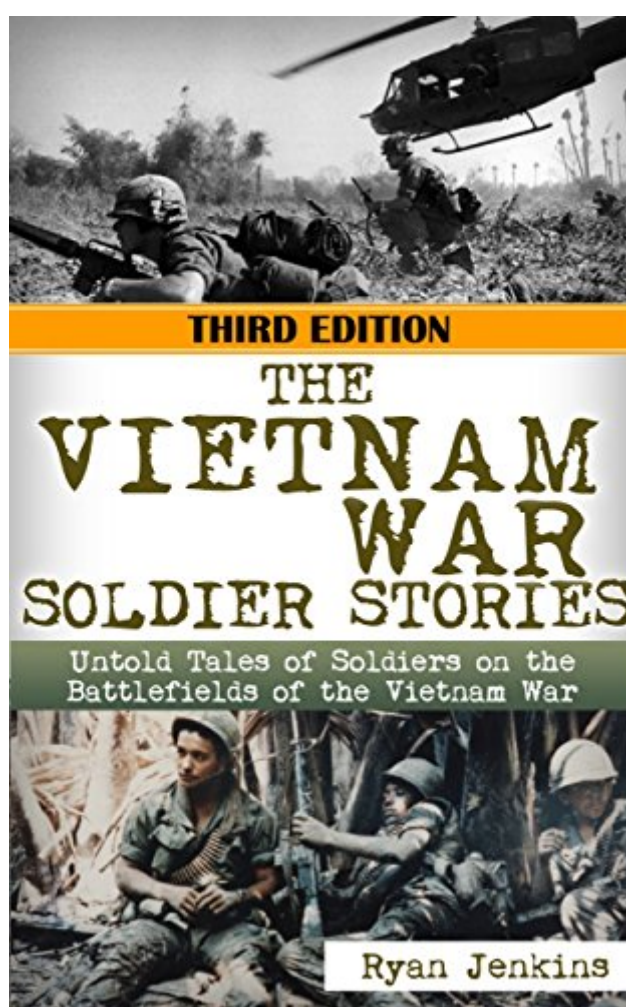

Newspaper documentation and photos, which are included in the book, remind us of the horrors of war and the people it affected, Vietnamese and Americans alike. While it mentions the tensions at home (those against the draft and the fighting), it also mentions the heroic acts of soldiers like the Green Berets and medics who risked their own lives to tend to those wounded. The details of the book are thorough and does not assume that the reader has a lot of background knowledge of the topic. The stories of the soldiers is important to share in order to better understand their involvement in this conflict.

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
