

Much to my satisfaction, the author shows that this can succeed in urban apartments, which is my exact situation! She gives various DIY methods on how to start hydroponics. Coupled with this is a lot of background information into the history and benefits of the hobby. In some cases, I wish the author went more in depth. For example, she mentions that we can deter spider mites with a cayenne pepper spray solution, yet she doesn't go into how to make it. Overall this was a satisfying introduction into hydroponics. I would highly suggest pictures to be included with the instructions though.

I'm a fairly experienced amateur gardener looking at moving to hydroponics from raised beds. I literally skimmed this book in under 5 minutes, not because I'm a reading whiz, but because the info is *very* basic. If you want to learn about what hydroponics is then this may be the book for you; if you want to learn about fertilizer ratios for your NFT system, then look somewhere else.
