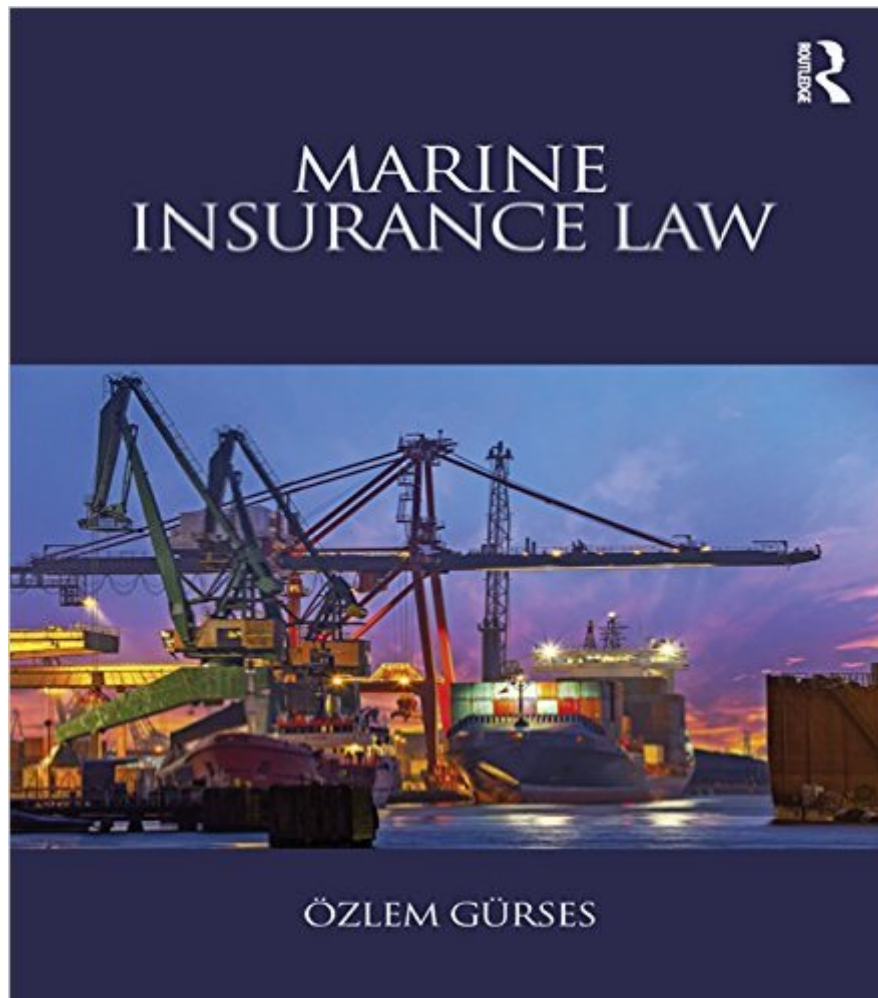

As with all the Routledge text books, this particular title is probably the best on the market as an introduction to the way in which 'Marine Insurance Law' operates in England and Wales for those new to this developing and quite complex area of substantive law. Dr Ozlem Gurses adopts a clear and simple approach with a legal vocabulary which is carefully measured throughout the book.
