

He went directly to the book and kept going back to it as he and his mom went through the basket. I ordered it just before we gave him the basket and was only able to skim through it before giving it to him. What I saw was filled with information about college life that an

18-year-old guy might not think about and was written in a style appealing to that age group. His sister is leaving for college in three years, and I hope he passes his copy along to her. If not, I would buy it again for her.

I first came across this book as a pick for our Book Club. We chose this book because a lot of us have first time college students and thought it would be helpful for our kids to have a "heads up" for what college life is really like. I liked it so much, that I purchased a copy to put in my daughters belongings to take with her to college. I even tagged the most important parts!

My daughter is headed to college and found this book to be "Handy", "Full of Good Information" and "rad". I take that to mean the book was a good choice.

I wish this had been around 25 years ago. Mr. Cohen covers most of the questions that might arise for entering college freshman in such a way that neither my nephew or I, nor his friends or parents found embarrassing or questionable when I included this edition with the shaving bag and essentials I purchased to commemorate his first year of dorm life, 1,200 miles from home. While I am certain that the enclosed, crisp greenbacks were most appreciated, he reported having devoured much of "The Naked Roommate" before the plane arrived at its destination.
