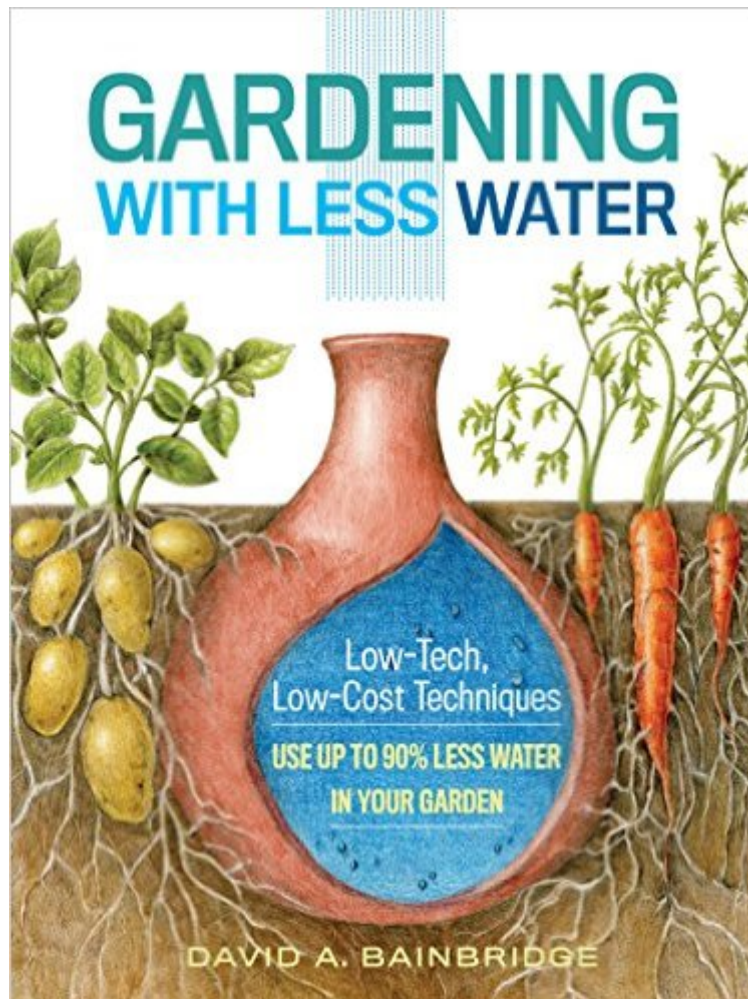

Living in the Adelaide Hills as I do, this is the perfect book of gardening advice for my area. We are a dry, arid area for most of the year and our climate soars into the low to mid 40's Celsius in the summer and drops to just below zero Celsius in the winter. As in, which forms of watering in this section were better suited to the use of grey water, and which werenâ™t? Yes the use of grey water was touched in chapters later, and sometimes almost mentioned during the different types of water saving devicesâ | but not enough for me to feel comfortable in using it with any of the new devices except maybe in deep pipe irrigation system.
