

But several sections of the book espouse a concerning, in my opinion, misunderstanding of Scripture and God's Sovereignty. In several places the author seems to be suggesting that God makes us wait because He's waiting for us in some way (sin, learning, etc). While that might sound good (and I can even see how it's tempting to say that) if God's waiting on us, that technically means we're the ones making God wait

which is a supposition not supported in Scripture. I was glad I read it but would not recommend it to others unless they had significant spiritual discernment to be able to separate the chaff from the wheat, as it were.
