

I love crossword puzzle books, and I like a challenge, but there weren't as many puns as I expected, no really amusing ones, and I can't remember working so many puzzles in one book where I thought, "I have never heard of such a word in all my life." And I am NOT an illiterate person! And some of the clues are right misleading; I thought, "how'd you get THAT?". Good number of puzzles, good size, easy to work. Just not the usual quality. For the price, it's worth the purchase. What I call "bathroom book."

Like most New York Times puzzles, these are well edited. They're not especially challenging, but many of the puzzles have some sort of interesting theme. All in all, a relaxing, interesting set of puzzles. However, the title -- "Tons of Puns" is inappropriate. I'd say there are no more puns in these puzzles than any random set.

I had hoped this would be a lot more challenging, but it is not. It seems to be a compilation of maybe Wednesday or Thursday puzzles from the Times. Too easy, I'm afraid.

Perfect...as always. Mixture of fairly easy and some not so easy, but challenging. Never disappointed in the New York Times crossword puzzles.

As an experienced crossword solver (OK I'm a tad obsessed) I found the puzzles in this book to be mildly to moderately challenging.
