

Maybe because some of it is so ridiculous, I feel the need to express myself. So let's get started. When Mickey and Emily were getting ready to go riding, Mickey was saddling Hampton and he puffed up full of air to keep the girth from being done up too tight. It said Mickey poked him in the side and told him to stop it and he "rolled his eyes" (quotes by me) and let out the breath. Well, unless Hampton is a cartoon, he can't roll his eyes in that manner.
